## Healthy Heart Check

There have been an alarming amount of teens who have died recently from sudden cardiac death. Playing sports can put strain on the heart and amplify underlying heart issues. Beaumont Hospital and Channel 7 are hosting a Healthy Heart Check at **Milford High School Friday, May 20th from 3-7pm and Saturday May, 21st from 9am-1pm.** They will be doing an in-depth heart screening for high school students with a medical review, blood pressure assessment, and EKG all reviewed by Beaumont doctors. Echocardiograms will be provided if needed. The screening looks for potential risks of sudden cardiac death.

Stuebenville, Ohio will be the location of our 2011 mission trip!!!!!!  
The date for the trip is **July 16th-24th**. We will be working in low income areas where families and elderly residents can't afford the cost of minor home repairs. We will help them paint, clean, garden, or whatever they need done. We will also help at a local kids club by doing crafts, putting on skits, and helping with lessons. It won't be all work though. In the evening we'll hang out together and see the area. We also have a free day to go off and have fun all day. We'll decide what that is at a future meeting.

This trip is a week of doing God's work in areas of our country that we often overlook. It will help build community in our own group, build a more accurate world view for the teens, and bring each one of us closer to God as we do His work. Friends are also welcome to join us.
